Terms and Conditions

Membership is limited

Membership is awarded on a first come first serve basis with the exception that priority will be given to those who are currently experiencing financial difficulties. Membership can only be granted to those living in the Horsforth and Kirkstall wards. Any applications received after the maximum number of subscriptions has been reached will be placed on a waiting list.

About the membership

- Membership entitles you to one visit per week, only one adult shopper per household to attend.
- Membership is restricted to one per household. Proof of address may be requested.
- You can pay your membership fee by cash, card or direct payment. Please ask a member of staff for details.
- Members are welcome to help run the pantry, please ask for more information.



Terms and Conditions cont...

Butcher Hill Community Pantry reserves the right to archive, pause or refuse your membership. For example:

- You do not use the pantry for a while,
- You move away from the area,
- You are abusive towards staff, volunteers or fellow pantry members.

Things to know when you visit.

- Members must bring their membership card and a cool bag or ice packs each time they visit.
- To ensure that members get a fair share we may place limits on certain items.
- There is no guaranteed availability of an item from week from week.

Food safety

If you suffer from allergies and intolerances and are unsure about the ingredients in a product please ask one of our volunteers.

We may receive some food products that come without labelling. However, in these cases we will provide a list of ingredients. Should one not be available please ask a volunteer.

There may also be items that have passed their "best before" date, in addition to our main stock which will all be in date. A best before date indicates quality, not safety. When this date has passed it doesn't mean the food will be harmful. The important date to look out for is the "use by" date – do not consume food after this date.
